



AWARDS: Three \$1,000 awards per school year per student for one year.

ELIGIBILITY RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. No participation will be permitted by relatives or dependents of the Lubin-Green-Cohen-Kiem Scholarship committee.
2. Applicants must be graduating seniors enrolled in a public, private, or parochial high school in St. Louis City, St. Louis County, or St. Charles County surrounding areas.
3. Applicants must rank in the upper 25 percent of their graduating class.
4. Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of:
 - a) Academic rank
 - b) Extra-curricular activities and leadership potential
 - c) Character references and other pertinent factors
 - d) Community involvement
5. Scholarship recipients must attend an accredited college or university on a full-time basis (includes junior colleges).
6. Scholarships are awarded on a one-time basis only and are not renewable.
7. The student can choose to receive the full amount (\$1,000) at the beginning of their first semester or one-half (\$500) of the award be available at the beginning of the first academic semester and the remaining half (\$500) at the beginning of the second semester. Proof of the student's registration must be received by Royal Banks of Missouri. Failure of the recipient to enroll in the second semester voids the remainder of the scholarship.
8. All applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee of Royal Banks of Missouri, as constituted by the Bank's Board of Directors. Their selection is final.
9. **Applications must be submitted no later than Wednesday, April 15th.**
10. 11. This is an independent scholarship program. There are no restrictions toward other scholarship awards you may receive during the same time period. However, you may request to disclose the awarding of this scholarship and other applications.
12. If for any reason a recipient is unable to accept the scholarship, a replacement may be chosen by the Bank's Scholarship Committee.
13. Royal Banks of Missouri reserves the right to terminate its Scholarship Awards program at any time, but recognizes its obligation to fulfill any scholarship agreement outstanding.
